JSEE has established cooperative agreement with ASEE, SEFI and KSEE, and a member society of IACEE, AESEAP and IFEEES. JSEE is the principal engineering society to support JABEE, Japan Accreditation Board for Engineering Education, and JABEE joined the Washington Accord as a full signatory member in 2005.
